A one-off design, though at the time it was thought more would be built. Instead Pakistan used the hull design to build missile craft. *Larkana* succeeds an earlier craft by the same name; unfortunately, the editor is unable to access his earlier editions of Jane's and there is no information on the Internet.

Larkana [P 157] conducted trials in 1992 and commissioned in 1994

Displacement: 150 tons; 182 full load

Dimensions: 39 x 6.7 x 1.7 meters (128 x 22 x 5.5 feet)

Propulsion: 2 diesels, 2 shafts, 5,000 bhp [3.4 MW], 23 knots

Crew: 35¹

Armament: 1 dual 37/60 mm AA, 2 dual 25/63 mm AA, 2 depth charge launchers
