COM HONO DIST TO COM 14: Instructions requested seizure sampans outlying Islands.

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- 0340 1410 CINCPAC TO CTF 8: No further information of enemy carrier but
 Radar reports planes moved to westward of Oahu and are now circling there.
- 0350 1420 CINCPAC TO CTF 8: Radar reports about 3 planes in flight. Ship launching them may have been cruiser. Army bombers also searching.
- 0414 1484 Radar screen now clear. Air raid warning in Pearl secured.
- 0400 14th ND OP OFF TO NAS, CINCPAC: Ensign John R. McCarthy USNDR 1430 Scout Squadron 6 ENTERPRISE reports he was shot down Sunday morning over West Loch. He bailed out and believed plane fell in Loch but may have drifted across into cane field. He was unable to jettison his confidential code information or lost plane procedure; if plane landed in came field its confidential information may fall in the hands of Japanese living in that area. McCarthy enemy plane was a single seat low wing monoplane fighter similar to P-36 at 3 to 4,000 feet altitude and had retractable landing gear. The wings were pointed taper estimated speed in dive 220 knots. Plane had no camouflage. Other enemy planes at one thousand feet altitude were two seater low wing with both retractable and nonretractable landing gears. Some had belly tanks. Estimated dive speed 170 knots. McCarthy confident that these were land planes and not carrier planes and that his ship was hit in accessary section by either .50 calibre incendiary or small cannon; ten seconds after being hit, fire broke out forward of cockpit. Engine failed at no time. Flotation back panel torn out completely. He feels that enemy equipment and piloting were much better than previous information had lead him to expect. McCarthy now in Navy Yard hospital with broken leg sustained by hitting stablizer in bailing out. Rear seat man, Cohn, RM3c, unaccounted for by McCarthy. This office disseminating this to fleet intelligence and CO NAS PH. END. LtCom Dickens.
